What is a conclusion? *The concluding statement consists of three important parts: restating the thesis statement, summarizing important points and leaving a final impression or thought with the reader. A strong conclusion ensures that the thesis is completely explained.*

TYPES OF CONCLUSIONS



CAUSE AND EFFECT CONCLUSION

- Summarize the main points
- Restate the thesis



COMPARE AND CONTRAST CONCLUSION

- Summarize the main points
- Restate the thesis



PROBLEM/SOLUTION CONCLUSION

- Restate the thesis
- Provide a real world connection
- Give a call-to-action



SEQUENTIAL CONCLUSION

- Restate the thesis
- Highlight the progression of events/steps
- Explain the significance of the information you've presented
- Offer a next step



DESCRIPTION CONCLUSION

- Circle back to the attention grabber
- Explain personal meaning
- Restate the thesis
